Nga Waka was founded by the Parkinson family with the planting of the Home Block vineyard in 1988. Roger Parkinson made every wine since the first vintage in 1993 and Vineyard Manager, Mike Kershaw tended the vines since 1996.

After 32 vintages Roger Parkinson retired as winemaker at Nga Waka. After 28 vintages Mike Kershaw retired as Vineyard Manager. We are thrilled to have Paul Mason continue Roger's legacy at the helm and create the next chapter as our Head Winemaker alongside Matt Harper as Vineyard Manager. Paul has built an enviable reputation of outstanding wines at Martinborough Vineyard for the past 20 years. Matt continues to bring passion and experience tending the vines at Nga Waka for the past 9 years.

We have seven small vineyards scattered around the village of Martinborough, producing mainly Pinot Noir and Chardonnay alongside smaller amounts of Sauvignon Blanc, Rose, Riesling, Chenin Blanc & Gamay. All sustainably grown and managed.

Our name is taken from Nga Waka A Kupe (The Canoes of Kupe). The three hills, which lie side by side like upturned canoes. These form the backdrop for the town of Martinborough and its surrounds. Legend has it that the hills were formed by the three canoes of the famed Polynesian explorer Kupe, which were carried inland by a huge earthquake and came to rest in the valley behind Martinborough.

Thirty years on Nga Waka remains family owned, now by Jay Short and Peg Dupey.

Our cellar door opened in mid October 2022. The architecturally designed building was the creation of Victoria Read of Aspect Architecture and Landscape Architect Hamish Moorhead. The building uses a lot of timber and carefully crafted design elements to emphasise and acknowledge the hand crafted yet complex nature of the Nga Waka wines.
